Guests come to experience backcountry skiing, develop their backcountry skills, and explore new terrain in a relatively safe, welcoming, social, and COVID-friendly backcountry environment. We bring together the comforts of a ski resort, the expertise of a guide service, and the adventure of the true backcountry.

Job Summary

We're seeking a Lodging and Hospitality leader to be the face of our recently launched Bluebird Basecamp Lodging Operation. The lodging leader is responsible for fostering a friendly, welcoming, and safe experience for all of our lodging guests. This position will live and work at Bear Mountain (Wednesday evenings if there are check ins) Thursdays - Mondays of the season. This individual will be responsible for: guest check in and out, cleaning and maintenance of the lodging and campsite facilities, and conducting routine inspections.

Duties

- Be the leader to launch our new hospitality initiative
- Guest Service creating a welcoming environment for guests and answering any questions
- Check In and Out of guests outside of normal business hours
- Completion of daily facility checklists
- General maintenance and inspections of the lodging operations, cleaning, upkeep of cabins, domes and grounds, and some snow removal
- Ensuring lodging accommodations are well stocked with firewood, propane, convenience items, bathroom necessities, and other items as needed
- Enforcing lodging rules and regulations
- Overnight point of contact for lodging guests
- Help shape and improve the lodging operations of Bluebird Backcountry

- Ability to work weekends and holidays

Compensation, Location and Housing

- This is a full-time, seasonal role from late November through early April
- Pay is \$24-\$27/hr, depending on experience
- Bluebird will be open 5 days per week from Thursday-Monday, plus possible holidays
- Must be able to live on site. RV, truck, or van living or on-site employee housing is available at a significantly discounted rate
